### COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS: SAFEWA Using the SafeWA venue QR code

From 5 December 2020, it will be mandatory for particular businesses and venues to collect contact details of customers and patrons by maintaining a contact register for WA Health Department COVID-19 contact tracing, if required.

To help, the WA Government has developed a free app, SafeWA QR code, which is an efficient and safe way to record patron and visitor contact details where they can check-in, using the app.



St Luke's Parish has registered for the SafeWA QR code. Parishioners can check-in, using the app. Download the SafeWA app from the [Apple App Store](#) or the [Google Play Store](#).

Visitors too can scan the QR code using the SafeWA app, or if are unable to scan the code for any reason, they can sign the hardcopy register.
