CREATED IN THE IMAGE OF GOD: AN IN-TRODUCTION TO CHRISTIAN ANTHROPOL-

Dear Parishioners, You are invited to join in our four week course that is being run in

Woodvale in October (Wednesdays, 9 – 30 October).

This set of talks will offer a Catholic perspective on what it means to be human. Utilising Scripture and St Pope John Paul II's Theology of the Body, it will delve into what it means to be made in the image and likeness of the Holy Trinity, how this forms the basis of our identity and human dignity, and how Jesus' death on the Cross gives the highest and deepest revelation of what it means to be human.

Participants will learn the meaning of being redeemed and healed in Christ, the importance of being made male and female, the vocation of every human person, and will be challenged to apply such principles as being "in the world, not of the world". This course belongs to a 4-part series on Scripture, Prayer and Sacraments, Christian Anthropology and Catholic Values.


